Church Recess started about six weeks ago. During this time 20 to 25 children (ages 4 through 5th grade) have regularly participated. We've taken note that the children enjoy the fresh air. They enjoy running, climbing, drawing with sidewalk chalk, and playing four square. We've learned how best to lead this group to and from the playground amidst the maze of building construction. We've encouraged hand washing at the end of recess. And, we've encouraged the child to arrive at Sunday School class ready to learn from their teachers.

On occasion we've noted that children have been dropped off by a parent out at the playground. If this is the case, we request that the parent simply talk to the supervising adults so that we can have accurate records of which children we are responsible for during this time.

There are still a few things we'd like to test. We've noticed a neat overlap, and it's that during church recess there could be time for Children's Choir (or possibly a Children's Musical sometime later on).

I'm very glad to announce that beginning on Sunday, November 8th, Monica Carlson would like to lead a choir for children (grade 2 to 5). The Children's Choir will prepare a few Christmas songs for Advent.
